Sir,

It is stated that assessment report (May, 2011) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Vydehi Institute of Medical Sciences and Research Centre, Bangalore for purpose of recognition of MD(Forensic Medicine) qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore was considered by the Board of Governors and it was decided as under:-

The Board of Governors considered the assessment report (May, 2011) and the recommendation of the postgraduate committee and decided that MD(Forensic Medicine) qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at Vydehi Institute of Medical Sciences and Research Centre, Bangalore be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admissions to 1(One) student per year.

The Board of Governors further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

6.4 *The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.*

6.6 *Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause-4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.*

You are requested to notify the above qualification at the earliest!

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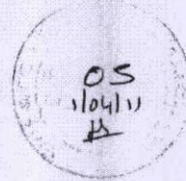
