It is stated that the assessment report (May, 2013) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Vydehi Institute Of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Bangalore for purpose of Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification against increased intake from 03(Three) to 04 (Four) seat(s) granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore was considered by the Board of Governors at its meeting held on 17.09.2013 and it was decided as under:-

"The Board of Governors considered the assessment report (May, 2013) and noted that MD(Paediatrics) qualification is already recognized with 03(Three) seat(s) and decided to recommend that MD(Paediatrics) qualification against increased intake from 03(Three) to 04 (Four) seat(s) granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at Vydehi Institute Of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Bangalore be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the L.M.C. Act, 1956 with the number of admissions to 04(Four) student(s) per year."

The Board of Governors further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

- 6.4 The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
- 6.6 Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause-4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.
