



WHEREAS, the Vydehi Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Bangalore, affiliated to the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka vide its letter No. VIMS & RC/ACM3/078/2021-22 dated 7.3.2022 applied for renewal of recognition of two seats (2) of MD (Emergency Medicine) qualification in respect of students being trained at the Medical College, having an annual intake capacity of two seats in the course.

- WHEREAS, Post Graduate Medical Education Board (PGMEB) scrutinized the Standard Assessment Form, of the inspection conducted of the College on 5.12.2022 and found deficiency of eight Senior Residents in the Department. The College was intimated of the deficiency vide PGMEB's letter No. 35/438(208)/2022-PGMEB/024106 dated 3.5.2023 and the medical college was given an opportunity to submit a written explanation in respect of the deficiencies.
- 3. WHEREAS, the College furnished its reply to PGMEB vide letter No. VIMS & RC/ACM3/022/2023-24 dated 19.5.2023. The reply of the College was examined by the PGMEB and found that it had failed to comply with the requirements prescribed in the various regulations notified by NMC/ erstwhile MCI and has compromised with the quality of medical education. Hence, PGMEB vide Order No. 35/438(208)/2022-PGMEB/004062 dated 25.1.2024 intimated regarding non-approval of any seat of the MD (Emergency Medicine) qualification. Further, the College was directed not to admit any student in the course of MD (Emergency Medicine) for the Academic Year 2024-25.
- WHEREAS, the College had preferred an appeal before the National Medical Commission under Section 35(5) of the NMC Act, 2019 and Section 9 of Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations, 2023 (MSMER-2023).
- 5. WHEREAS, the Appeal Committee of the NMC in its meeting held on 2nd and 3rd May, 2024, found that the Department of Emergency Medicine of the College had improved subsequent to the order sent by the PGMEB and vide order dated 3.7.2024 decided to restore the number of seats appealed by the College.
- THEREFORE, PGMEB accords the approval in terms of Section 25(1) and 35(4) of NMC Act, 2019 and regulation 7(1) of MSMER-2023 for continuance of two seats of the course of MD (Emergency Medicine)

in respect of students being trained at the Vydehi Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Bangalore under the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka.
