The agenda of the conference with the theme of 'An Update on Epilepsy CME' covered a range of crucial topics




Overview of Epilepsy

During this session, the importance of advancements in neuroimaging was highlighted. It also delved into various imaging techniques for diagnosing and localizing epileptic foci.






Medical Management of Drug-Resistant Epilepsy
